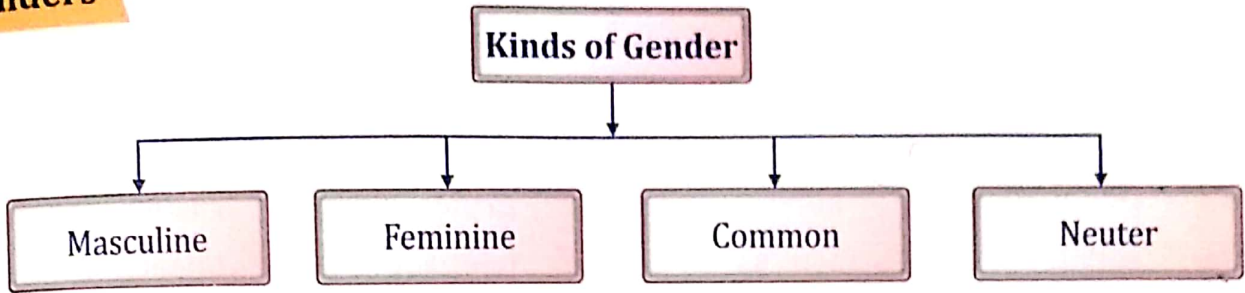


Genders

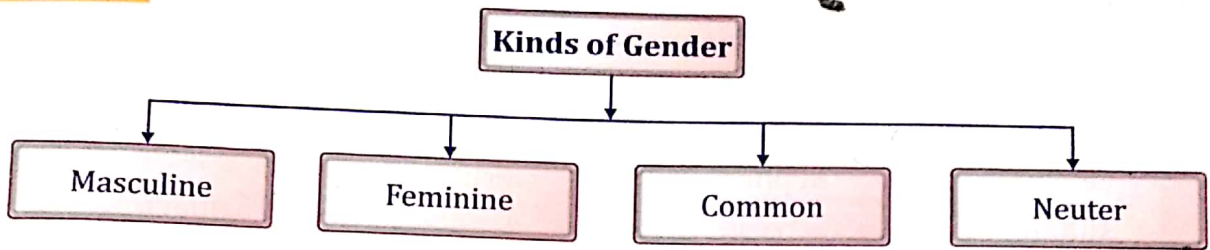
