

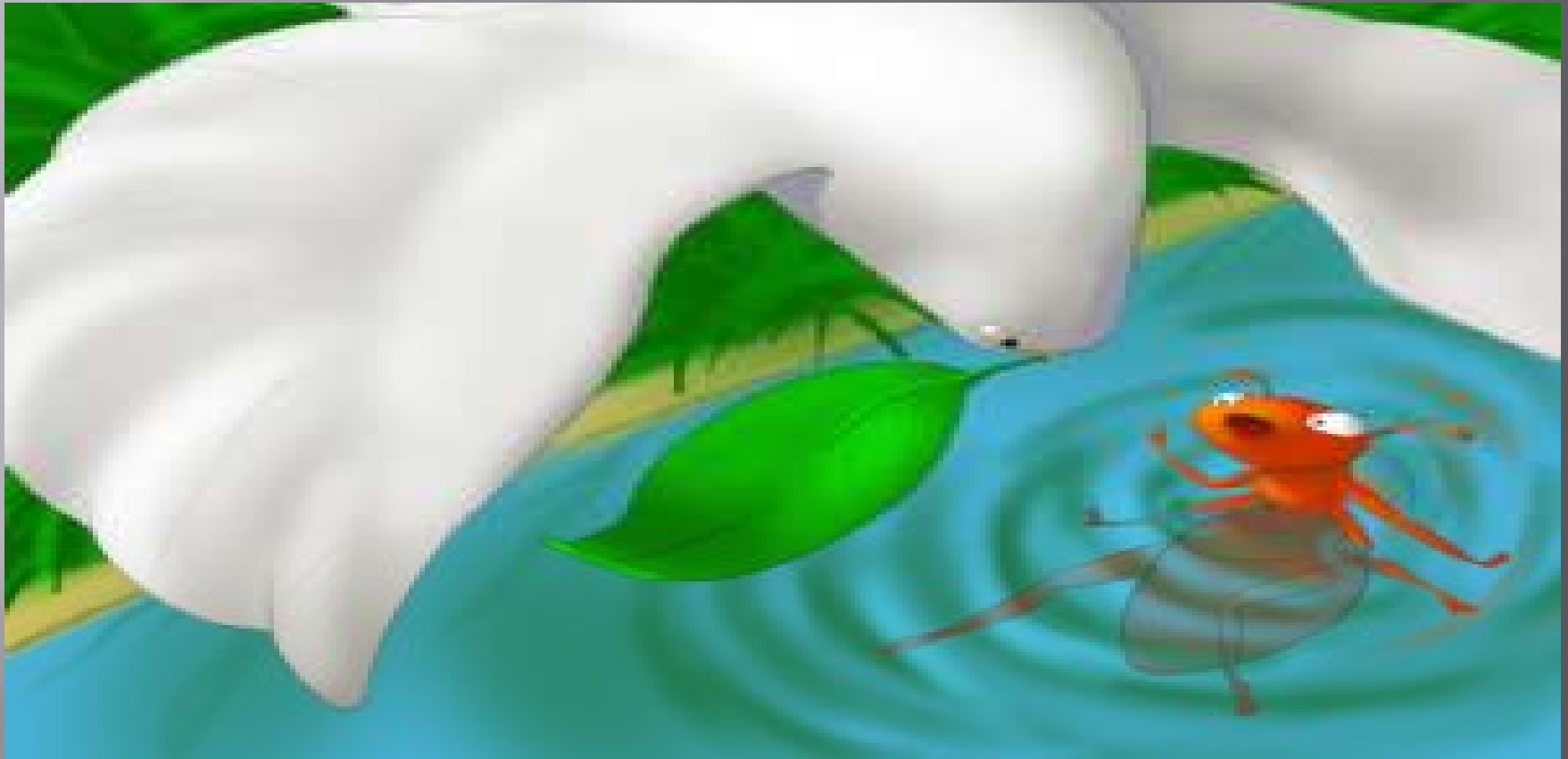




One day an ant stopped at a river bank to drink some water.
