

Types of Sentences

Declarative

- A Declarative sentence tells about something.
- It ends with ' . '

Examples-

I have a pet dog. (Affirmative)

I don't have a pet dog. (Negative)

Always speak the truth. (Affirmative)

Never tell a lie. (Negative)

Interrogative

- An Interrogative sentence asks something.
- It ends with ' ? '

Examples-

Where do you live?

What are you waiting for?

Imperative

- An Imperative sentence tells someone to do something that is a command, a request or an advice.
- It ends with ' . '

Examples-

Don't be selfish. (advice)

Please open the door. (request)

Bring a glass of water for me. (order)

Exclamatory

- An exclamatory sentence shows excitement and strong feeling.
- It ends with ' ! '

Examples-

Wow! What a lovely dress.

What a pretty girl!

Hurray! We won the match.
